B. VENMO AND ZELLE DONATIONS.

The I.S.O. received a total of \$1,644.78 via Venmo and Zelle in the month of February. I.S.O. has been receiving approximately \$1,500 - \$2,000 per month through this platform.

C. PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM (PPP).

A response was finally received related to our submitted paperwork for loan forgiveness. As a reminder, I.S.O. received \$47,262.00 in May 2020. After the bank reviewed the paperwork, they submitted to the Small Business Administration (SBA). SBA approved \$43,430.15 to be forgiven. A check was written and signed for \$3,865.95 (the payoff amount of \$3,831.85 plus interest of \$34.10) at today's B.O.R. meeting. Karen did an excellent job working with the bank and completing the paperwork.

TWELVE STEPS

In the previous issues of this year's Bulletins, I mentioned that Item #50 on the current order form "Gamblers Anonymous Writing The Steps" is a great piece of literature for working each of the 12 Steps of Recovery and that we would be making one of the exercises from each Step for the corresponding month available for your use right here in the Life-Line Bulletin. If you want to complete the other exercises, each booklet can be ordered from the I.S.O. for \$2.75 each plus shipping and handling.

STEP 4

Made a searching and fearless moral and financial inventory of ourselves.

Step 4 Preparation Exercise: Write Your “Gambling Autobiography”

Go back in your memory as far as necessary — to childhood, if appropriate — to identify the history of your relationship with gambling. What’s your earliest memory or experience of betting, wagering or gambling? You may not have been a participant, merely an observer. What do you remember most about the experience? Can you recall how you felt about it at the time? Did it capture your interest or stir your emotions? Did the activity itself appear acceptable and innocent or dangerous and taboo? What part did the incident play in your forming an early opinion about gambling?

Start with your first recollection and write about it and all subsequent incidents and experiences with gambling throughout your life. Notice whether, along the way, you had a sense of your attitude and participation as “normal” with regard to gambling. When did you first notice changes in your attitude toward gambling and/or your involvement in it? Did other people bring those changes to your attention? How did you feel and respond when they did? What behaviors did you develop? Also notice whether your changing attitude(s) toward gambling or the gambling itself began to affect choices/behaviors in other areas of your life. Use specific examples!

Creating a “gambling autobiography” enables us to paint a clear picture of ourselves as compulsive gamblers. We may learn that we were “normal” gamblers who became compulsive. Or we may notice that compulsiveness or some indications of it were present almost from the start. By chronicling our gambling history, we can trace the formation of the guilt and shame we carry today. We may begin to see how our early gambling-related attitudes and experiences are connected to our present-day choices/behaviors. Most importantly, we can start to identify the specific character defects — self-delusion, “big shot”-ism, lying, stealing, manipulation, pride, irresponsibility, wastefulness, self-pity, isolation, greed, jealousy, resentment, laziness, impatience, arrogance — that made it possible for that guilt to accumulate.

Temporary Guidelines for Video Meetings

- Protocol for entering and staying in video meetings using platforms such as Zoom, WebEx, etc. and video meetings in which members can attend either by video or telephone.
- Attendance only by video
 - In order to enter the meeting, members should first be placed in a “waiting room” if the platform has this type of functionality. The purpose of the waiting room is to quickly determine the identity of the attendees and let them into the meeting either one at a time or en masse. When the waiting room feature is utilized, it is recommended that the meeting consider having at least two facilitators, one to monitor the waiting room and one to facilitate the meeting.
 - If the platform does not have this type of functionality, the meeting secretary or facilitator must assume the duty of identifying all attendees before the meeting begins as well as any attendee who arrives after the meeting has begun.
 - Attendees who are not known to the waiting room facilitator should be further questioned as to the reason for their attendance. If they identify themselves as compulsive gamblers in need of a meeting or new members, they should be taken at their word and admitted to the meeting. The nature of the meeting (open or closed) will also determine the admission of those other than compulsive gamblers, and the final say on admission will rest with the waiting room facilitator.
 - If anyone refuses to identify themselves to the waiting room facilitator, they should immediately be dropped from the waiting room.
 - The meeting, through a group conscience, may elect to have all attendees turn their cameras off.
 - If #5 above does not occur, attendees should still be given the option of turning off their cameras and appearing on screen as a “placeholder” or avatar.
 - Attendees should caption their pictures, “placeholders”, or avatars with their first name and last initial only or any other caption that masks their true identity.
 - Virtual backgrounds that may camouflage others who are sharing the member’s meeting space should not be used

- Attendance by telephone
 - Members who wish to attend a video meeting by telephone must be screened using the same methods as above so their identity is known to the waiting room facilitator and/or meeting facilitator.
 - Callers who refuse to identify themselves or whose caller ID is either blocked or shows “anonymous” shall not be allowed to attend.
- Announcements that should be read before each and every meeting (if not included in that meeting’s customary announcements)
 - There will be absolutely no video or audio recording of any kind, including screenshots.
 - Our meeting facilitators have done everything humanly possible to ensure that this is a secure meeting. However, because of the nature of the media we are working with, we cannot guarantee absolute security and thus, anonymity. Therefore, we ask that members not discuss...
 - Any crimes for which they may still be prosecuted
 - Anything of such a sensitive nature that it could potentially harm that member or any other members should that information be surreptitiously recorded and leaked.
 - Members who are especially concerned about their anonymity are invited to turn their cameras off and/or change their screen name.
