C. HARASSMENT BROCHURE.

The International Executive Secretary sent a copy of the proposed two-page Harassment Brochure to our attorney for review after the November B.O.R. meeting. The attorney's response was received and disseminated to the Board of Regents members prior to the meeting for review. The attorney wrote "**I strongly advise against the board using the current document.**" A motion was made: "After the legal opinion from our attorney and in an effort to protect Gamblers Anonymous, the Board of Regents will not print or distribute this material."

A. UPDATE ON OFFICE STAFF.

## TWELVE STEPS OF UNITY

**Unity** – Something that is complete within itself, with a oneness of purpose of thought and spirit.

For the compulsive gambler who walks through the door, out of a want and need to stop gambling, and with a desire to become a member of Gamblers Anonymous, it often seems to be a tremendous task simply to stop gambling and restore oneself to a normal way of thinking and living. In the beginning there is an understanding confusion of the mind and the normal impatience. We try to open our minds to share with others who have experienced the first steps of recovery.

The new member often blocks out any discussion of the Unity Program for a period of time, and even those members who have abstained from gambling for longer periods often avoid or put aside the need for discussion and the acceptance of the Unity Program for any number of reasons, but the truth of the matter is the great need for an understanding of the progress of our recovery, made possible by the tools that are available to us as contained in the Steps of Unity.

The Gamblers Anonymous Unity Program is a framework for the well-being of individual groups and the Fellowship as a whole. The Unity Program is outlined in Twelve Steps and is meant to insure the continuity and perpetuity of Gamblers Anonymous.

In order to maintain the Fellowship for present and future members, both individuals and groups follow the proven concepts upon which the Unity Program is based. The essence of this program is in the preservation of common welfare, members understand that what is best for the group is best for each individual.

The Unity Program serves to protect the Fellowship from disruption. Members work together under the principles of unity in order to preserve and perpetuate the opportunity for themselves and other compulsive gamblers to recover and grow within the Fellowship.

## STEP 2

### **Our leaders are but trusted servants; they do not govern.**

Gamblers Anonymous relies primarily on group conscience to keep functioning. Leaders within the Fellowship are entrusted to carry out the will and conscience of the Group. They have assigned responsibilities but they act only within the authority granted to them by the group to serve the group.

We shall be held responsible if we elect irresponsible Trusted Servants who cannot serve the group in the manner determined by the “Ultimate Authority” which is the spiritual concept of “Group Conscience.” They are not elected to command, order, demand, change, alter, but simply to serve and express the opinions determined by the group through a conscious consideration of opinions expressed by all members of that group. Trusted Servants in each group are rotated, so that each of us may be reminded and remember that we serve for the good of all, without authority over anyone.

Ego and pride tend to become lost if one listens to the Group conscience. Acceptance is the spirit and trait which can carry one through.

### **From Your International Executive Secretary**

We are often asked what does the International Service Office do? And how does Gamblers Anonymous get their money? For the past several years in the February issue of the bulletin we have included “How the I.S.O. Receives Its Money” and “What the I.S.O. Does”. If you have previously read this, I would offer this as a reminder that we are still carrying the message and thank you in advance for reading it again.

### **“WHAT THE I.S.O. DOES”**

- Answers telephones, e-mails and all other correspondence received.
- Sorts and distributes daily mail received.
- Updates and maintains the Gamblers Anonymous International Directory on our website.

- Maintains reports for all money received through QuickBooks and processes receipts for all donations; Lifeliners, Cans, Groups, etc.
- Processes and sends all orders; received by mail, fax and from our on-line store.
- Prepares and sends Starter Kits to those requesting them and keeps the Trustees informed of when and where meeting kits are going.
- Sends “Information Packets” with a letter about Gamblers Anonymous to the many people requesting information on our Program.
- Sends pertinent information to Trustees, Regents and membership as needed.
- Keeps an inventory of literature on hand.
- Orders and inventories all Office Supplies.
- Prepares ending monthly Accounts Receivables Report for Intergroups and sends invoice copies that are due to be paid.
- Processes receipts for all accounts receivables and literature orders.
- Balances ledgers to deposits and makes weekly bank deposits.
- Prepares monthly Operating Statement and does complete accounting procedures for the Office.
- Keeps track of all accounts payable and processes the checks for bills that are signed by two of three mandatory signatures of the Board of Regents.
- Compiles, enters, and proof reads all letters, donations, anniversaries, etc. for Life-Line Bulletin on a continuing basis.
- Constantly updating and reprinting (or upon approval by the Board of Trustees) printing new literature.

## **HOW THE I.S.O. RECEIVES ITS MONEY**

**LIFELINERS - (Not to be confused with Life-Line Bulletin Subscription)** A Lifeliner is an individual donation from a member on a monthly basis. You can pledge any amount you wish. It is a personal thing and only you and the International Service Office know the amount you give. If you are interested, the form to fill out is on the back cover of this bulletin.



**CAN CONTRIBUTIONS** - A Can contribution is a direct donation to the I.S.O. Groups pass around a can at their meeting and then send a check or money order once a month totaling the amount collected. If you do not have a Can or Can number, and would like one please let us know and we will see that you get one.
