B. FINANCIAL SOFTWARE UPDATE.

Karen H. reported that we have acquired a new temporary employee to assist with the start up of QuickBooks accounting in the I.S.O. The new temp., Linda, is working three days a week and has been extremely helpful and knowledgeable. She has been a definite asset during the learning curve period for Karen H. and her staff on the new software. We are still planning to be fully operational on July 1, 2017. Karen H. also reported that Linda will not be able to stay on even though we would like to hire her as the permanent replacement. Our search for a permanent replacement shall continue.

C. E-READERS FOR COMBO BOOKS.

John C. gave the report that the Combo Books have been revised with a new edition dated 05/2017, and stated that business accounts have been setup with Amazon for the Kindle platform and also Barnes and Noble for the Nook platform. We ran into some

formatting problems but these are being addressed. John also reported that the I.S.O. shall be receiving payments in a different manner from each company. Amazon only pays by direct deposit. Barnes & Noble will be paying by check. This was considered satisfactory by the B.O.R.

D. LIFE-LINE BULLETIN PAGE & MONTHLY/YEARLY COUNTER.

A discussion concerning adding counters to the website to record how much usage the electronic version of the Life-Line Bulletin is running into several obstacles. The I.E.S. mentioned that she uses the online Bulletin frequently during the month. Each time it would be recorded as if it were a different member. Since the B.O.R members that suggested putting on a counter wanted to do so for curiosity sake. No action is being taken at this time by the B.O.R.

John C. stated this agenda item is the result of agenda item 60 from the Spring 2017 Trustees meeting. There were questions regarding the wording of the Pressure Relief literature. Trustee David M. asked for this item to be on the May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Board of Regents meeting and it was tabled to this meeting.

John C. has received quotes from two attorneys. John has requested a vote to approve an amount not to exceed amount of \$950.00 for an attorney to review all Pressure Relief Forms with regards to risk/liability. There was a motion to approve.

G. REPORT FROM THE FUTURE PLANNING COMMITTEE.

Peter A., Committee Secretary, reported that the committee has been meeting regularly by conference call on the first and third Thursday of each month. The committee has a list of possible projects all aimed at preparing the I.S.O. and G.A. for future growth and facilitating the Office work flow. Recently Steve F. and Bill B. have left the B.O.R. and resigned from the committee. Three active members remain – Peter A., John C. and Bernie G. After discussion at their last meeting it was decided to wait until the new Board is seated to elect a new Chair. The new B.O.R. members were invited to join the next call, on July 6<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 pm EST. There will only be one meeting in July, due to the timing of the next B.O.R. meeting. If interested, any new B.O.R. member should contact one of the current members for the call access information.

3. NEW BUSINESS

Prior to discussing New Business, John C., Chair read a letter from the Chair of the Board of Trustees, Andy R. that was written to the Board of Regents.

John also asked to discuss Item B prior to item A.

B. DISCUSS COMPLIANCE AUDIT.

John C. stated that at the Spring 2017 Trustees meeting during the discussion of Agenda Item 7 (regarding an Operational Audit), several Trustees related stories of other 501c3 corporations that were not in compliance with state and federal requirements. As a result, they lost their 501c3 status and spent several thousands of dollars to become compliant and re-establish their 501c3 status. John has received two bids from attorneys that work with non-profit organizations and is requesting that we contract with one of these attorneys for an amount not to exceed \$1,500.00. A motion was made to table the item until next month when the new Board is seated.

A. VOTE ON B.O.T. AGENDA ITEM 7, “REQUEST FOR OPERATIONAL AUDIT”.

John C. reported that according to By-Law Article XVIII, Section 1, any agenda item to be proposed at an upcoming Board of Trustees meeting that directly affects the By-Laws, I.S.O. or the functions of the I.S.O. must be discussed by the Board of Regents meeting prior to the Board of Trustees meeting. The Board of Regents Chair or an assigned representative of the Board of Regents will speak on such items at the Board of Trustees meeting to convey the thoughts of the Board of Regents. The Board of Regents Chair or assigned representative will then convey the discussion and the resulting votes to the Board of Regents at their next scheduled meeting. If the item passed at the Board of Trustees meeting, the Board of Regents will take a vote on that item, and that vote shall be recorded in the minutes. If the proposed change is to the By-Laws, then that vote shall require a favorable vote of not less than six (6) members of the Board of Regents.

It was called to the attention of the Board of Regent Chair, John C. by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees Chair, Andy R. that there was no discussion conveyed to the Board of Regents at their May Board meeting and only the resulting vote was conveyed was that the item had passed. John then proceeded to convey the discussion from the Board of Trustees meeting which included several Trustees relating personal experiences of other Non-Profits that had lost their non-profit status. John C. reminded everyone that this is an agenda item and is not a By-Law, therefore requires only a majority vote to pass or fail.

## STEP 7

**Humbly asked God (of our understanding) to remove our shortcomings.**

Humility, the basic foundation of each of our twelve steps of recovery. Without some degree of humility no compulsive gambler can surrender to the first step, or continue to grow through the remaining eleven. At Step Seven, we begin to see humility as a path to freedom, and a peace not known before.

Prior to entering G.A., I had always looked upon humility as humiliation and surrender as defeat. Humble meant a distasteful slice of humble pie; an admission of weakness. Pride and ego ruled my thoughts and actions. God took a back seat to myself knowledge and willpower.

I surrendered to Step 1 out of desperation and despair and even though this first venture in humility was painful, it seemed the better alternative to prison, insanity, or death. At each of the following steps, I would grudgingly give up some of my will rather than return to the certain death of gambling. Slowly, as I began to recognize that my way had created all of my problems, I began to trust more and more in my Higher Power and the G.A. way of life.

After inventorying my character defects and sharing them with another, I hit a confusing road block. Many G.A. brothers and sisters had shared in therapy that they were “working” on their character defects. What did that mean? Weren’t all of these problems I had just listed of my own making? How could I have the ability to “work” on their removal? At this point, a kind old timer took me aside and shared that my “work” was in Step 6. I had to be entirely ready to have these defects removed and to try, to the best of my ability, to change. Being human, he said, I would fall short of this lofty goal. It is here, he told me, that God, if asked with humility, would remove my shortcomings.

A great weight was lifted from me as I humbly asked God to remove my shortcomings. My attitude towards humility changed from something that I must have, to something that I really wanted to seek as a way of life. God, of course, answered my plea for removal of my character defects. God’s answer to me was, “Make a list of all persons you have harmed and become willing to make amends to them all”.

Dear G.A.I.S.O.,

We have lost our beloved Frank C. He was my right hand man at the Roseburg Tuesday Night G.A. for the past three years. Frank arrived just when we needed him most, from California where he had started a meeting in Lake County. While in California, Frank sat at many meetings alone and read literature. He was there, week in and week out. He paid the rent himself often to keep the meeting going. All he knew for sure is he needed a meeting and so do others, so he made that happen.

Over the ten years that he chaired a meeting in Lake County he saw it ebb and flow, sometimes with as many as a dozen or more members in attendance. He left that meeting in the hands of a capable group and always talked of his hopes that it was still going. For 16 years our meeting in Roseburg had gone much the same as the one Frank started in California, building up to a dozen at one time and dropping off to a few. When Frank arrived at his first meeting here it was just the two of us. We shared and as most compulsive gamblers do, we found our

stories much the same; not only our gambling but our recovery. From then on, I was never alone at a meeting. Frank had a lot to share and a gentle and unassuming way of sharing it. He gave peer therapy in kindness and had a “take it or leave it” approach, never trying to shove anything down another’s throat. From one he sponsored it was said “He had a strong message. His story was much like mine, as all ours are.

To say I related to him would be an understatement. I am forever grateful to have crossed his journey. I could not have said it better for all of us at Roseburg Tuesday Night G.A. He told me that first meeting, not to wait until I was in a casino to call him. It would be too late. Call him at the first urge to gamble. That first meeting I took an immediate liking to Frank. Short of stature, tastefully dressed in a windbreaker jacket with some sort of golf club emblem; he wore a Titlist hat. He didn’t look like a degenerate gambler. He looked like what he was: an ardent golfer who I later learned played golf five or six days a week weather permitting.

I walked into my first G.A. meeting in Roseburg, on a rainy November night. I walked in with the full intention of walking out with a sponsor. The previous night I had gambled 8 hours straight, maxed my ATM withdrawal for the day and emptied my wallet. Nothing new for me, there except this time before I started gambling I had bargained with myself. Self-bargaining is something compulsive gamblers are adept at. I had promised myself that if I lost yet again on what had been a particularly long and painful losing streak I would seek help immediately - like now. I had been down this long, lonely road before. In Santa Barbara, California 20 years ago at one point I was attending three different G.A. meetings a week. It helped. Lots of support, and if nothing else I was using “spare time”

wisely, rather than sitting at a slot machine or handicapping the morning odds for the afternoon's race at Golden Gate race track. The trouble for me was G.A. says you must have a sponsor for any real hope of long term recovery. I balked at that idea. I am fiercely independent. I didn't need a nurse maid. I could work the twelve step program alone. I was wrong. I couldn't do it alone. Frank and I started meeting for lunch. He told me his story.....Then 12 years ago he joined G.A., and worked the program,

In the next decade he repaid every penny he had borrowed or stolen. Frank had his dignity back. His wife (I don't even know her first name) stuck with Frank. He used to tell me over and over just take it one day at a time. Get up every morning say to yourself, just today I'm not going to gamble.

The only meetings Frank missed in the year and a half I knew him was the three meetings he missed when his wife had surgery. He stayed by her side. Still he checked with me by phone to make sure I was hanging in there.

Frank guarded his anonymity. He didn't want outsiders knowing about his addiction. One day I went in the Oakland grill where we met for lunch. No Frank. I asked the waitress if she had seen Frank. Frank who? she asked. Now I was stuck. Frank walked back inside after having a cigarette. Frank loved his cigarettes.

I got a call last Monday from our G.A. group leader, Kathy. She told me Frank was dead. He had had a heart attack. He had been hospitalized a week earlier with chest pains but told Kathy he expected to be checking out of the hospital the previous Friday. But that didn't happen. I asked about services or memorials. None planned. No services public or private. I said to Kathy, I didn't even know his last name. She told me his last name. I don't think I will share his last name. Frank wouldn't like that. He cherished his anonymity as I said before.

I wanted to call his wife and tell her how much Frank had helped me and many, many other recovering gamblers. I didn't have her phone number or even her first name. Frank had a cell phone dedicated solely to his GA endeavors. That line was dead.

How would Frank want to be remembered? He was a great friend to me and others. I'm sure he would like to be remembered as a friend. Then there was Frank, the golfer, he would enjoy that title. Most of all though, I think Frank would have liked to have been remembered as a man of integrity and perseverance who took life, One Day at a Time and won.

Frank was 68 years old.
