STEP 11

Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God as we understood Him, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.

Working the 11th Step is quite simply the most important thing I do towards recovery on a daily basis. Through prayer and meditation, I am able to practice acceptance, which is critical to my recovery since only through acceptance do I realize that my benevolent Higher Power, which I choose to call God, is in control, not I. The realization gives rise to serenity and is the best tool available to working on eliminating my character defects.

Working the 11th Step is not easy, but I find the reward it offers well worth the effort. First I have found that I must approach prayer and meditation with a spirit of appreciation and gratitude. By consciously acknowledging my blessings and thanking my Higher Power for them, my prayer becomes a joyous experience, a celebration during which I share a tremendous sense of affinity and well-being with my Higher Power which may sustain me for hours if not the whole day.

Second, I have found that I must do exactly as the step instructs, that is, pray for the knowledge of God's will for me and the power to carry that will out. I have found that when I focus on my perceptions as to my own specific needs and wants or those of my loved ones, prayer becomes drudgery. However, when I simply pray as instructed by Step 11, with an earnest desire to become more spiritual, my needs and those of my loved ones are always met. And, most importantly, my awareness of my Higher Power, and how He works through my life, continues to grow.

The significance of the spiritual principles emphasized by G.A. cannot be understated in working the 11th Step. I find that my prayer is always answered when I consciously practice humility, openmindedness and willingness. Similarly, these principles, as well as honesty, seem to be the key to attaining a sense of fulfillment during meditation, which I also strive to do on a regular basis.

G.A. and its program for recovery continue to work miracles in my life, and I will never be able to express my gratitude enough. I am thankful to have this opportunity to describe how working the 11th Step helps in my recovery. Indeed, just before Karen called me to give me this opportunity, I was rehashing a just concluded, and extremely frustrating, telephone call with an IRS agent. As always, G.A. rescued me from myself. Thank you G.A., you are always there when I need you-which is every single day.

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

As most of you already know, we recently lost a truly dedicated member of our fellowship, Irwin S. from New Jersey. Not only was Irwin a devoted member of Gamblers Anonymous, he was my friend.

I first met Irwin in the fall of 1988 at the Orlando Board of Trustees meeting when I was a brand new Trustee. He really made an impression on me during that meeting. The next time I saw him was in May 1989 at the Omaha National Conference and Board of Trustees meeting, which was my first National Conference as the I.E.S. During that Conference he invited me to attend the Eastern Conference to be held the first weekend of August 1989 in Parsippany, New Jersey (back then we had four National Conferences with two of them hosting the semi-annual Board of Trustees meetings). I attended that Conference, which Irwin was the Conference Chairman and remember having a wonderful weekend full of recovery.

Irwin touched so many lives with his knowledge of the Gamblers Anonymous program and dedication of wanting to continue giving back to the program that saved his life for over 44 years.
