STEP 10

Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong, promptly admitted it.

It's not about gambling or not gambling, it's about living Life on - on Life's terms. Corny? I guess so. Accurate? Absolutely!

In working the first nine steps of recovery, I've taken responsibility for my past actions. STEP 10 asks me to take responsibility for TODAY. I'm asked to do what's right - because it's right.

NOT because it will benefit me.

NOT because I may be found out or punished if I don't.

NOT because it looks good.

ONLY because it's right!

Today, because of GAMBLERS ANONYMOUS and our Recovery Program, I can make morally free decisions and take action on that basis.

However, sometimes those decisions may not be appropriate and my actions cause problems (for me or for someone else). If I don't address my inappropriate behavior in a timely manner, then I'm acting like the old Norm and not taking responsibility. I can't afford to go back there. Life's too good, and I've come too far.

Also, admitting a mistake, correcting it (making amends) and learning from that mistake FEELS GOOD.

But, in continuing to take a personal inventory, what if I find that what I've done is O.K. How do I handle that? I really believe that I need to acknowledge those actions as well as the negative ones. A small pat on the back helps to keep me straight just as much as to promptly admit when I'm wrong.

The really neat thing that I've found about STEP 10 is that it's become "Second Nature". Most of the time I'm working it without even knowing that I am.

In closing, I really need to express my gratitude to GAMBLERS ANONYMOUS for making the "Divinely Inspired" Steps of Recovery part of my LIFE.
