D. Standing Rules Committee Report – John C.

- Discussion on potential Standing Rules change – Motion to be discussed under new business.

E. ERC (Employee Retention Credit) Follow-Up – Israel A.

- Office Manager informed the B.O.R. that the auditors were asked about the ERC. Requested numbers were provided. Based on income, we would qualify for one quarter.

A motion was made to proceed with the ERC process.

F. Finance Committee – John C.

- There have been two committee meetings since the last B.O.R. meeting.
- There have been suggestions for increases in literature pricing on some items.
- A question was raised why the I.S.O. does not have a link to make Venmo or Zelle donations on our website. The Office Manager said this could be looked into, but it would be difficult to know if the donation was truly from a member of G.A. The Chair said we should explore this further and model this process after other organizations.

NEW BUSINESS

A. REVIEW PROPOSED STANDING RULES CHANGES: – John C.

- **DISCUSS THE PURCHASE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR ALL B.O.T. MEETINGS.**

A motion was made to add under Finances: page 3 of 4, item 11. The Board of Regents shall discuss the purchase of liability insurance for all Board of Trustees meetings.

B. DISCUSS THE PURCHASE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE B.O.T. MEETING IN CANCUN. – John C.

- John C. has discussed this with many different companies. The lowest premium would be \$600. Will keep pursuing a quote.

C. DISCUSS LITERATURE PRICING. – John C.

- A comment was made that pricing may not be the problem, but the Fellowship's awareness of our literature may be lacking, and that the Trustees need to communicate to groups and members about G.A. literature.
- The Office Manager is getting quotes on various quantities to explore better prices and reduce costs. Paper and ink costs are going up. Literature prices have not been raised in over 4 years.

D. DISCUSS HAVING THE I.S.O. ACCEPT EMAILS FOR LITERATURE ORDERING.

- A preliminary email address has been created but will not be published until the board determines to move forward.
- Concerns were raised about security of credit card information and if an email under a particular domain would be vulnerable to hacking.
- The Chair mentioned that before anything moves forward, we want to make sure everything is secure.

E. APPROVE AMENDED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 2022-JUNE 2023

- The Office manager explained that actuals were amended for auditors and the budget did not change. The Chair determined that this item would be removed from Agenda because the budget has already been approved.

F. DISCUSS US BANK CD MATURING IN OCTOBER. – Arnie B.

- It was brought to the B.O.R.'s attention that there is a financial services company that can offer higher CD interest rates. A 6-month CD with this company can have a return of 3%+.
- There is a representative of this company that could come to a B.O.R. meeting and explain the advantages of using their products/services.
- It was suggested that the Finance Committee possibly invite this representative to a committee meeting instead. The committee will discuss this issue.
- The maturing CD will be discussed at the October B.O.R. meeting.

UNITY PROGRAM

Did you know that the I.S.O. sells a booklet on how to study the Unity Steps? We do! It’s called “Gamblers Anonymous Group Study Book on the Unity Steps.” Each month of 2022, I’ll be listing the Unity Program corresponding step with each month. I’ll be taking information from both this booklet and our red book, A New Beginning. Both of these are available on the Gamblers Anonymous website or order form.

As I entered my first meeting on July 30, 2001, at the Unity Club in Las Vegas, my brain was focused on one thing – to stop gambling. It’s all I cared about for the first few months I was attending meetings. I had no idea what the Unity Program was or why it existed.

As my mind cleared up and I started to understand my surroundings, the Unity Program became less and less confusing for me. I’d like to think it’s the same way for all of us, however, I can only speak of my experience.

It taught me that while I needed to focus on **MY** recovery, I also needed to respect the group as a whole and be one with them as we move forward on this journey of self-discovery and recovery.

Unity Step 10 – Gamblers Anonymous has no opinions on outside issues; hence the Gamblers Anonymous name ought never be drawn into public controversy.

The survival and growth of Gamblers Anonymous is of far greater importance than taking positions on any issues outside the Fellowship. To make public pronouncements on non-Fellowship matters would inevitably split the group. Individuals naturally have differing opinions and eventually these differences could erode group unity. By engaging in outside issues, the Fellowship’s concentration would be diverted from our main purpose, which is to aid in the recovery of compulsive gamblers. The association of the Fellowship’s name with public controversy would unnecessarily antagonize some portion of the general public. By avoiding controversy, both individual groups and the Fellowship as a whole are able to concentrate on the aims and principles of Gamblers Anonymous.

We must always be available to assist others in obtaining information concerning the problem of compulsive gambling without giving our opinion.

- a. Define/discuss: “no opinion;” “Gamblers Anonymous name;” “outside issues;” “public controversy.”
- b. Do we ever give the impression that there is a “Gamblers Anonymous opinion?” Discuss.
- c. If members are discussing the effects of a local Indian casino during a break, how does this relate to Unity Step 10?
- d. If a member shares that counselors and psychologists don’t work, or shares on other 12-step programs, is this violating the 10th Unity Step? Why or why not?
- e. How does Unity Step 10 support the newcomer? How does this relate to our common welfare? Our primary purpose?
- f. If we are distracted by outside issues, how will this affect our recovery within Gamblers Anonymous?
- g. How does my share/therapy affect this step?
- h. When we speak, we are encouraged to share our experience, strength, and hope.
- i. Can I share about my personal opinions, and will this affect the welfare of Gamblers Anonymous as a whole?
- j. There are several principles that may apply to this step. Elaborate on how each of the following applies to Unity Step 10: non-judgmental, keep it simple.
